Throughout his career, Jonker has demonstrated an ability to build lasting, trust-based relationships with Boards, Indigenous communities, key interest holders, and staff. His extensive governance experience spans provincial government, Crown corporations and agencies, and the non-profit sector.

"His wealth of experience in governance, strategic planning, and capital project management will be invaluable as we continue to grow and serve our communities.
